


Dear Mr. DelForn:

The Board of Supervisors at its meeting on March 12, 1997, granted your request for a revocable Provisional Use Permit in order to permit a billiard parlor with extended hours to 2:00 a.m., Part of Parcel 70-A-4, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Customers shall be required by management to leave the premises, including parking areas, immediately after the close of business.
- 2. The operation of the business shall not cause loitering, criminal assaults, public nuisance or an unsafe condition in the area surrounding the business.
- 3. The interior of the business shall be visible from the parking lot area at all times.
- 4. At least one (1) security person shall be on duty on each night from 10:00 p.m. until the close of business and their duties shall include monitoring activity in the parking area.
- 5. No activity shall take place at the rear of the store between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. and no dumpster service shall take place between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.

The Planning Office has been advised of the action of the Board of Supervisors and requested to revise its records and to place a copy of this notification in the Provisional Use Permit Index.
