Dear Mr. Schmitt:

The Board of Supervisors at its meeting on June 9, 1999, granted your request for a revocable Provisional Use Permit in order to permit a controlled density subdivision in conjunction with C-40C-99, on Part of Parcel 27-A-3A, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The project shall comply with the submitted Exhibit Plan, dated April 9, 1999 and revised June 2, 1999 by Youngblood, Tyler & Associates and with the following:
- 2. The applicant shall provide a centrally located recreation area as shown on the Exhibit Plan \_ at least one-half acre in size that will serve as a focal point for the community.
- 3. The applicant shall provide pedestrian connections to the proposed elementary school and to adjacent subdivisions including sidewalks along Twin Hickory Road.
  - 4. The applicant shall provide for the future extension of Autumnwood Way to the west to connect with adjoining development.
  - 5. The applicant shall provide evidence to the County of U.S. Army Corps of Engineers permits for any proposed activities in the wetlands prior to the County issuing the first building permit in the subdivision.
  - 6. Maintenance of all common open space shall be the responsibility of the community association assigned the responsibility for the overall Twin Hickory development.
