The Extension Office anticipates filling all orders received by February 19, and will process all orders received thereafter on a first-come first-served basis. Strawberry plants cost \$6 for a bundle of 25, and blueberry plants are \$3.50 per plant.

The Extension Office will distribute the plants on March 18 and 19 at the Glen Allen Softball Complex on Mountain Road.

Henrico County's Department of Finance reminds residents that the second half of the 1998 Personal Property and Real Estate taxes are due by Monday, December 7.

Payments may be made at the Western Government Center Administration Building located at 4301 E. Parham Road, and the Eastern Government Center at 3820 Nine Mile Road. Deposit boxes are mounted on the front of each building for 24-hour use. Payments may also be made at any Wachovia or First Union bank, or mailed with a postmark date no later than December 7.

Citizens who own or lease their personal vehicles will receive a 12.5 percent refund of the personal property taxes paid on their vehicle for 1998. Prompt payments received by Henrico County will result in an expeditious refund from the Commonwealth of Virginia.
