## **Assault and Battery Arrest**

On June 7, 2020 at approximately 5:45 p.m., the Henrico County Police Division received a call from the Richmond Police Department in reference to an incident that occurred during the protest walk on Lakeside Avenue near Vale Street. The adult victim had stopped to report the incident in the City near the AP Hill Monument. Several witnesses reported that a vehicle revved their engine and drove through the protesters occupying the roadway. The driver of the vehicle, Harry H. Rogers, age 36, of Hanover County was arrested. He was charged with assault and battery. The victim was checked by rescue at the scene and refused any further treatment.
